GENERAL OBJECTIVE

The overall aim of the Learning, Teaching, Training Activity is to share and experience useful techniques and approaches aimed at educating young people around self-entrepreneurship, conceived as a transversal competence.

Each group representing its sending partner organization will present min. 2 good practices about entrepreneurship education adopting an active and participatory approach.

The core, common guidelines proposed are based on four (not exclusive) teaching and learning methods associated with entrepreneurship education: active learning, project-based learning, experiential learning and activities outside the classroom/school that connect students with the local community and businesses.

These methods can be supported by audio-visual materials/ presentations and role-playing games.

In this way, each participant will be teacher-learner and active creator of the training course, in a peer-to-peer and cooperative learning perspective. At the end of each day a round table will be organised to be able to share reflections or make proposals and/ or objections to the activities carried out.

TARGET GROUP

The LTTA target group consists of total 20 Trainers/teachers/educators (4 per partner) active in the VET sector and able to share best practices about entrepreneurship education and/or want to learn these practices from their international colleagues. This means that the LTTA participants will be trainers and learners at the same time, in a view to promote peer education; they should exchange and test the contents and teaching methodologies around entrepreneurship education and then propose them to others, in order to be able to grasp the strengths, difficulties and challenges that may be encountered in putting them into practice with students.

Upon return in their national contexts, the outgoing skills and the satisfaction of teachers/trainers who will have experienced the training course will be detected, and the necessary corrections will be applied to the learning program to be then gathered into the project Handbook – the main project's deliverable.
